Classes of Membership

Full (A1)	Squash and tennis
Squash (A2)	Squash only
Tennis (A3)	Tennis only
Family (F1,F2,F3):	Squash and tennis for all family members
Aged 18-25 (B1)	Squash and tennis
Junior (B2)	Aged under 18. Squash and tennis. Free use of court if not being used by adults. For squash, hours of play as for Off-peak Membership.
Off Peak (O1)	Hours of play: squash - 9.30am to 6.00pm on Monday-Friday; any time on weekends and bank holidays. Tennis - no restriction.
Weekday (W1)	Squash and tennis, weekdays 9.30 to 6 pm
Social (S1)	Snooker, pool and other facilities, not tennis or squash.
Junior social (B3)	Snooker, pool and other facilities, not tennis or squash.
Associate Playing Member (X1)	For adults to play only with junior members - rules for hours of play apply as per juniors.

Court Fees

A court fee of £4 is payable in advance per 3/4 hour squash court session and for 1-hour tennis court session. Bookings open 2 weeks in advance. Juniors may book courts 3 days in advance. Visitors and Social members may play squash or tennis only six times (each sport) per year: full court fees are payable plus a supplement of £4 per player (£2 at off-peak times).
